

BLOOMING BERRY WREATH

Skill Level: Beginner

Materials: Wire wreath form; polypogon (green cattails); pepperberry clusters; willow eucalyptus; achillea filipendulina; dried protea blooms; spool wire; wire cutters; garden clippers; hot glue gun and glue sticks.

Directions:

1. Cut eucalyptus into 10 inch pieces. Place several pieces on form; twist wire around base to secure. Secure eucalyptus to cover entire form in overlapping layers in same manner.
2. Cut 10 inches of wire for each pepperberry and achillea cluster. Twist wire around each cluster; twist wires around form to hold in place and glue to secure.
3. Glue protea blossoms to inner edges of wreath.
4. Glue polypogon into spaces between berries.
